**First Sunday of Lent**  
The second reading from Saint Paul to the Romans is a favorite of those involved in the ministry of evangelization. There are no “secret” disciples of the Lord. Those who exercise good stewardship of their faith realize that publicly identifying themselves as followers of Christ has a cleansing effect on their lives. Openly confessing Christ makes them more conscious of how they live their daily lives. Are we content to privatize our faith or are we good stewards of a faith that we share, make public, and regularly identify as a life in Christ?

**THE CHOSEN**  
“The Chosen” is a television series created by Dallas Jenkins and financed by donors throughout the world. It is a wondrous and respectful presentation of the life of Jesus and His followers. Faithfully based on Sacred Scripture, the series offers a new and insightful look at the person of Jesus, both God and human, and the personalities of the people of His time on earth, especially the ones He called to follow Him. The creators of the program do not want to replace scripture but encourage all to read and pray with scripture.

The word ‘Lent’ comes from the Old English word for ‘Spring’. Even though the forty days of Lent echo the forty days that Jesus spent in the desert, even though it is a time of fasting and penance, it is still a time to discover in the barrenness of the desert the wonders of new life. It is still a time to prayerfully search deep within ourselves to discover the new life that God calls us to embrace. Each grain of sand, each hint of new spring growth, each blossom of promise nudges us to Resurrection, to New Creation, to Easter Joy.

We fast and pray and do good deeds in Lent, not to impress God or win His love and affection; His love is always ours. We do these holy things to learn, to grow, to become aware of our dependence on the Holy One. We do these things to allow His grace to mold and fashion us, to prepare our hearts for His resurrection, our resurrection.
