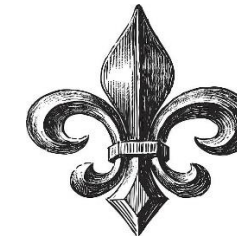

**(July Fest)**

Communion from the cup  
 We have begun to serve Communion from the cup at the 8:00 mass. In the month of May, we hope to begin serving the cup at Saturday 4:00 and Sunday 10:00 masses as well. The following is a reminder on how to receive from the cup: after receiving the host, approach the Eucharist Minister serving the cup, simply bow before the Eucharist, the Minister will say, "The Blood of Christ", you answer, "Amen", the minister will hand you the cup with the precious Blood, you take a small sip, return the cup to the Minister, bow once again and return to your place in church. The person receiving from the cup should never dip the host in the cup, but simply take a small sip. If you are uncomfortable with drinking from the cup because of the possibility of spreading illness, then please do not drink from the cup. The same goes for if you are not feeling well or may have a cold or something more serious, then please do not drink from the cup. Even though the Body and Blood of Jesus is present in the host itself, it is still a wondrous gift to once again "partake of the cup".
