
Kind words can be short and easy to speak, but their echoes are truly endless. *Mother Teresa*  The Baptism of the Lord


SECOND COLLECTION Bishop's Services Appeal All weekend masses January 8 & 9, 2022

If you would like a Poinsettia you can pick up one Sunday afternoon on the north side of church Scrupulosity creates an anxiety within us to such a lethal degree that we see sin where there is no sin. Every dangerous thought, every possible distraction, every aspect of humanity with its limitations and weaknesses, becomes a sin. Not only does it become a sin, but it borders on the unforgivable. Once again, there is no room for God's mercy. Surely, He cannot forgive us when we have an angry thought or an impatient feeling, a disturbing desire or a resistance to prayer. Do not misunderstand this reflection. Sin is very real. It is around us and within us. But the need to be scrupulous is a painful, treacherous valley that is difficult to maneuver. It promises us perfection by naming everything as sinful, as mortally sinful, thus destroying our trust in a merciful Father. Because we are so convinced of our innate evil, we limit God's mercy and love. When we limit God, that is

the very definition of idolatry. Of course, we confess our sins, but we must also allow that God forgives those sins. He does not seek our destruction but lifts us to Himself in love.
